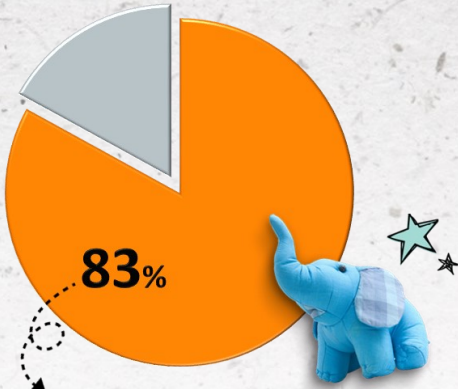


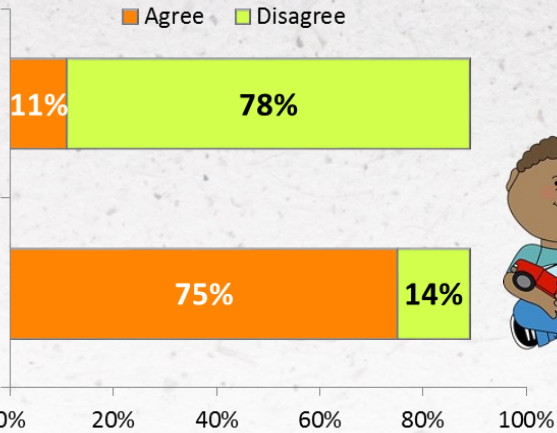
Taking Care with Child Care

The vast majority of Manitobans say the lack of child care in Manitoba is a very serious (37%) or somewhat serious (46%) issue.

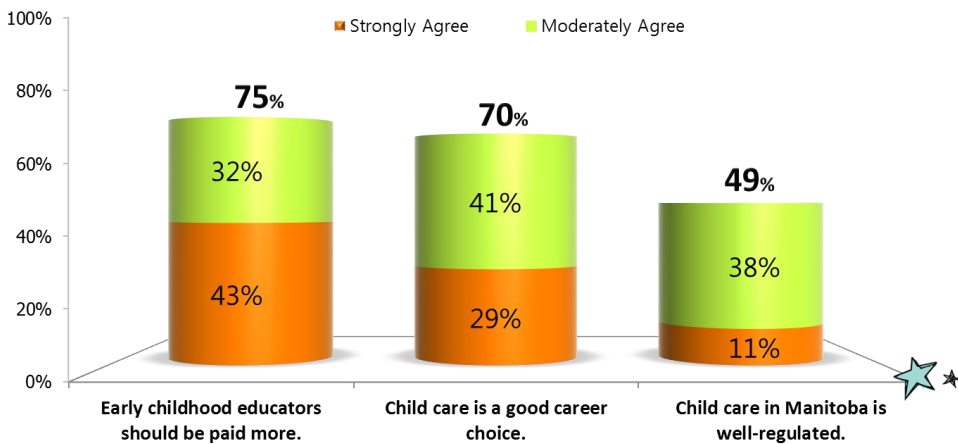
It's easy to find a child care space in Manitoba.



Child care is too expensive for many parents.

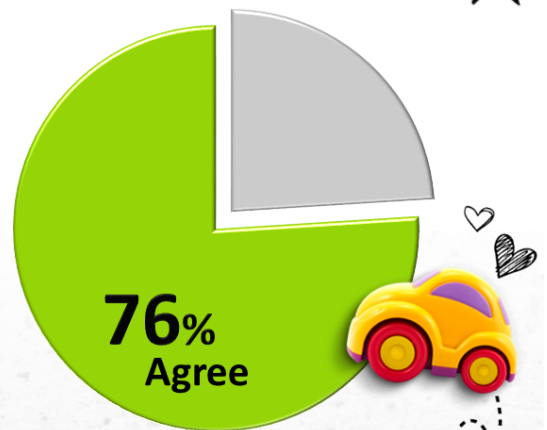
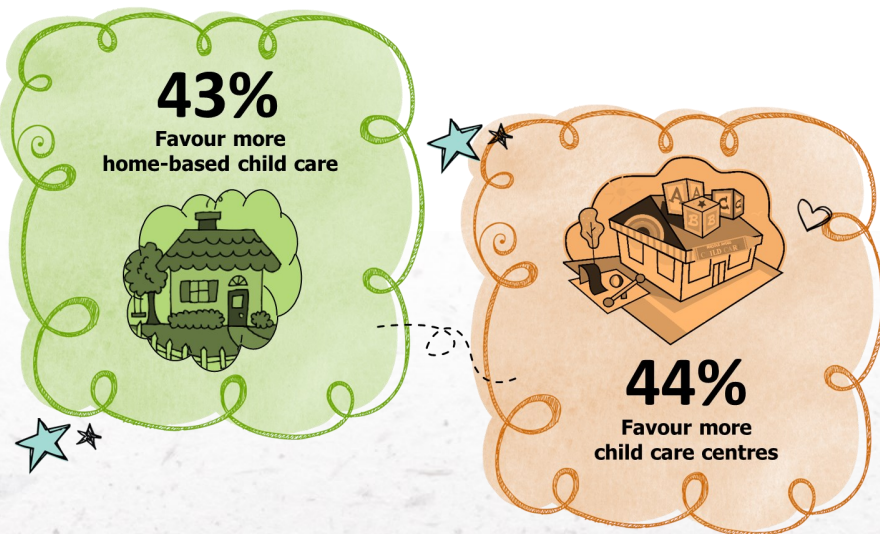


State of the System



Manitobans were asked whether they agree or disagree with the following statements about child care.

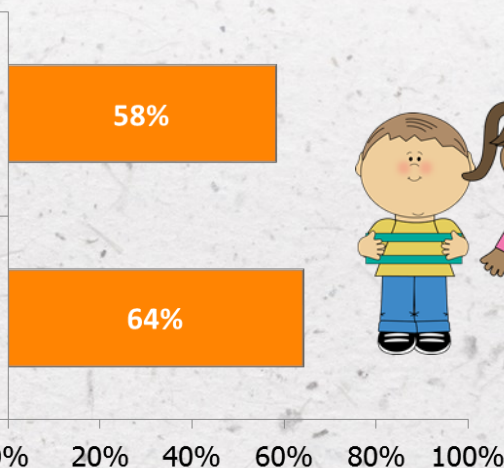
Child Care Fixes
